Public Hearing to Determine the Use of Proposition 30 Education Protection Account (EPA) Funding

- The voters approved Proposition 30, The Schools and Local Public Safety Protection Act of 2012, on November 6, 2012.
- The District must hold a public hearing to determine the use of the funds, which must be nonadministrative.

 Not new money—without passage, the District would have faced additional State cuts

 WSD's EPA estimate for 2012-13 = \$1,133,327

Restricts funds to resource code 1400

Must be used for non-administrative purposes

- EPA funds generated from temporary increases to the State's sales tax rate and the personal income tax rate for upperincome taxpayers
- Not subject to the passage of the annual State budget
- Must report on the District's website how much money was received from the EPA and how that money was spent.

- Can't contribute to the resource code
 - Should spend the exact amount received each year
- Staff recommends spending the funds on teacher salaries/benefits
