**2.1 Superintendent Update – Craig Guensler**

Superintendent Guensler reported that the Reni Dinner was a huge success. He stated that it is always amazing to see that the community supports the event.

Mr. Guensler stated that the evacuation went as smooth as possible. He said that he was in constant contact with the Board, Vic Ramos and Jeff Roberts, as well as the Y.C.O.E. He stated that Wheatland was still in an advisory evacuation situation on Tuesday, February 21<sup>st</sup>. Kathy Ellison had driven the bus routes and many of the roads were still flooded. The road closures and flooding was unsafe for staff, our buses and students. After much consideration, it was decided that the Wheatland School District would be closed on February 21<sup>st</sup>.

Mr. Guensler stated that the Wheatland School District will be filing for a waiver through the State. If the waiver is approved, we will not need to add days for this year. He feels that it is very likely to be approved, but there is no guarantee.
